Monday 21st October – Parent Evening Week. Appointments will be sent out beforehand.

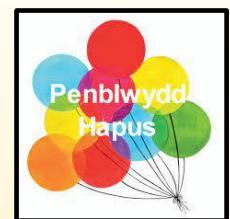

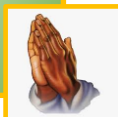
Absences
